Later in the month, we headed to a village south of Kiev for some evangelization. We are thankful for what the Lord did, and *is* doing, there. One of the boys there was Misha. He’s in the picture with me, below. With my broken Russian and Perry’s help, together we told Misha how to be saved, and Misha prayed for the Lord to save him from hell! Misha’s relatives got saved, too! Bro. David Loman led Uri, Misha’s brother, to the Lord! David just headed back to the States and is looking to start deputation. We were able to see several young and old villagers make professions of salvation after hearing the preaching of the gospel! As they say in some parts of the south, “We had us a time!”. We went down to the village the following week for some discipleship, and a few of them said they were reading the bible. Sasha, a national that lives near the area, will look to now gather them up for weekly services. I’m going to try and get down there as much as possible—being an American makes me kind of like the “new toy at Christmas”.
