Once again, I'd like to start out by saying thank you for your prayers. Perry and I had a great time of fellowship and evangelism together, working with some of the national Bible Believers that live in Ukraine. The tent was filled with children nearly every day. The adult services were much thinner, but there were several adult visitors, and a few came more than once, including a couple of older teenagers/young men. The Lord knows how many received Jesus Christ as their Saviour, but we think that maybe almost a dozen did during the course of the weeks' meetings. Perry and I stayed at a church in Zhitomer, a city 40 kilometers from the village where we evangelized. We had to drive from the church to the village twice every day, about 100 miles a day. I figured with the trip from Kiev to Zhitomer, and back, that would be a total of nearly 600 miles for the week. It was well worth it!

On the last day, because one of the Orthodox priests had a problem with us being there, we were almost going to have to conduct services without the tent. But, at the last minute, the director who had been dealing with us told us if it rained we could go ahead and pitch tent. Just as we started to begin, it started raining, and everyone joined in quickly to help set-up the tent. After the trip, two nationals remain there, and a hall is being rented to try and start a church there.
