Firstly, I want to thank all those that gave funds for the vehicle purchase. There is more paperwork to fill out, and other “obligations”, in order for the transaction to be completed. Lord-willing, we will try and finish the transaction soon.

I’ve been making trips to Rubchyenky once a week. They know Russian, but speak Ukrainian amongst themselves, so I don’t understand much of what they say, unless we communicate to each other with the little Russian that I know. We’ve been having a good time visiting with each other, just trying to keep in contact. Misha, Yuri, and Yulia (Julia) have told us they are still reading their bibles, so that’s really good. In July, Lord-willing, there will be a five-day event in Rubchyenky that will be “all-day, every-day” to help “confirm” the saints, and hopefully lead some more to Jesus Christ!

Yaroslav and I went to the burn clinic a few times this month and on one occasion were able to get a clear presentation of the gospel to a mother and her son, and a teenager who was in the next bed. We’ve given tracts out there as well, and last time we saw one of the nurses reading the gospel tract.

We are at a new address now; we moved to another apartment last week. The contract on the old apartment was going to expire soon, and we wanted something closer to church. This location is still fairly close to metro stations and markets.

Alexander, our tutor, will be coming three times a week this month to review what we’ve gone over so far. I’m looking forward to this and am praying that it will be a real help. I’m asking God to give me a special ability to speak Russian.
