Greetings from Ukraine!

We arrived at the airport on Dec. 7th, and flew out of Ohio to D.C. , to Germany, and then to Ukraine on the 8th. From beginning to end it took about 24 hours. Joanna got to witness to an Egyptian lady that sat next to her on the plane.

We stayed with the Demopoulos family when we first arrived. That gave us some time to look for an apartment. We found one that we are happy with; it is located near many stores and is well-lit, with many people traveling all around us. It is a good place for passing out tracts and once the weather gets warmer we can do some more outdoor evangelism.

Perry and I went out to the “vagzal”, the international train station, and did some evangelizing to the crowds. An older lady came up to me and asked for something. I was in another area, but took her to Perry, because he speaks Russian well. She asked for a bunch of tracts; she said she likes passing them out and that she was headed for the electric train and was going to pass them out there. Later we went to another spot, a waiting area, and passed out tracts. I saw a man whose countenance was a little perplexed. I offered him a tract, he took it, and then Perry started talking to him. He was very interested and he asked Perry to show him where the Bible talks about “the gift of God”...he wanted to know about ‘God’s gift’ that he heard/saw before!!! (‘Tis the season!!) It turns out this man was from Uzbekistan, a predominately Muslim country. We prayed with him, and he “called upon the Lord to save him”! We gave him a gospel of John and Romans, which he took gladly. I’m looking forward to going to that place again and many other “fishing holes” in the city’s complex.

About a month ago in the States, Joseph Lords called me to invite me to a Bible study. I asked prayer for Joseph in our June-July 2008 newsletter concerning salvation. He told me that he had gotten saved and would like prayer for his wife to know the Lord as her Saviour. I worked with Joseph pre-deputation and the Lord had burdened my heart for him.
